Be a source of encouragement (acknowledge the uniqueness of their child's interests and talents)

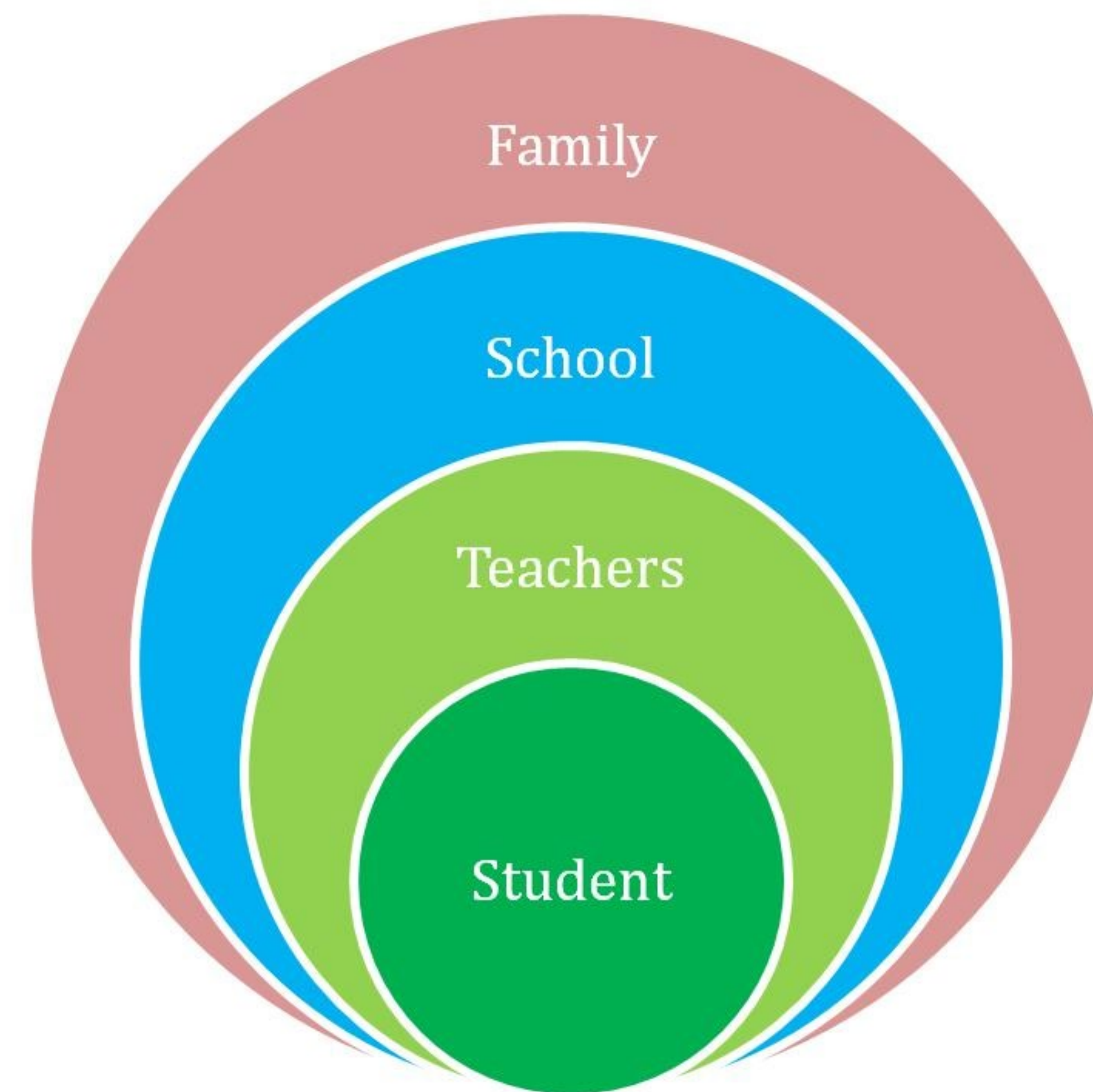
Help them set achievable goals

Barriers to progress

- Unclear post-18 plans
- Lack of realistic UCAS application
- Not revising Year 12 work
- Assumption that Year 13 will be the same as Year 12
- Poor use of Independent Study time
- Lack of communication with sixth form team regarding progress and/or emotional needs
- Poor attendance
- Use of mobile phone/social media
- Too many hours part time work



Attendance and Punctuality

- Attendance is directly related to success in school
- The higher a students' attendance usually the they achieve
- **Raising Standards**
 - 97% Target for students attendance
 - 90% = missing half a day a week
 - 80% = missing one day a week
- **Attendance policy**
 - Phone call from teacher
 - Meeting with teacher/ Attendance
 - Meeting with SLT

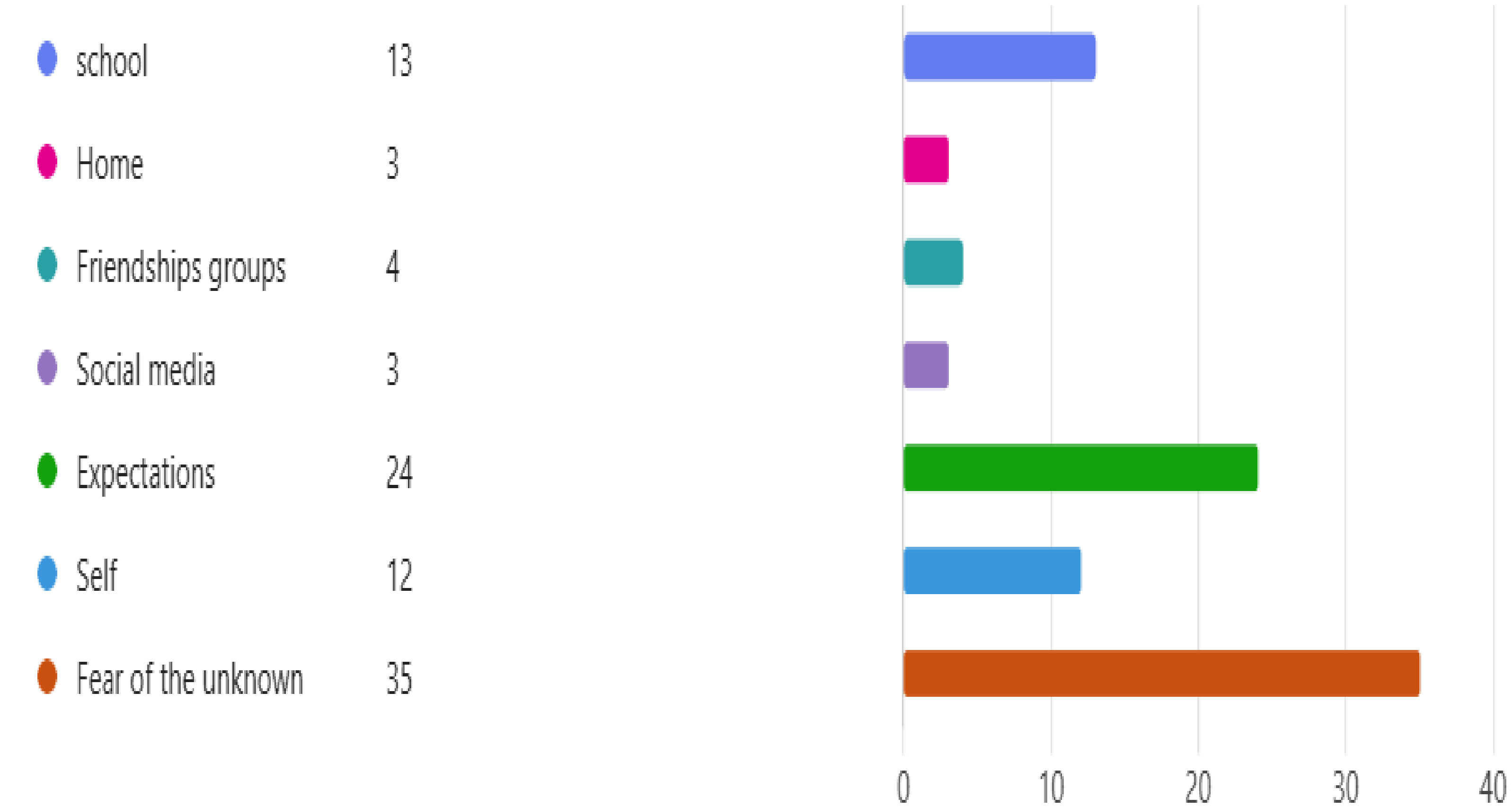

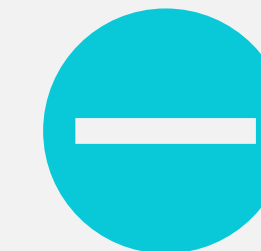

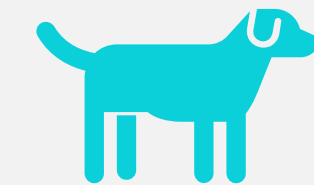

Understanding Student Finance

Two Main Components

Student finance consists of tuition fee loans and maintenance loans. Both are administered by Student Finance England.

Non-Repayable Support

Additional grants and bursaries may be available for students with disabilities or dependents.

Income Assessment

Most financial support is means-tested based on household income. Be prepared to provide financial information.

Tuition Fee Loans

Key Information

- Covers full cost of university tuition
- Paid directly to the university
- Available to most UK students
- £9,535 per year for 2025/26

Important Considerations

- Different rates for private institutions
- Additional years may be funded
- Differs for Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland
- Must apply each academic year

Maintenance Loans

£14,135

London Maximum

The highest loan amount for students living away from home in London for 2025/26.

£10,830

Outside London

Maximum maintenance loan for students living away from home outside London.

£9,118

Living at Home

Maximum amount for students living in their parents' home during studies.

Actual amounts vary based on household income. Higher incomes typically mean lower loans.





Application Process

1

January 2027

Application system opens. Create accounts on Student Finance England website.

2

March 2027

Submit applications. Parents complete financial sections with household income details.

3

May 2027

Deadline for guaranteed funding. Late applications may delay payments.

4

September 2027

Funds released. Tuition paid to university; maintenance paid to student account.

University Bursaries

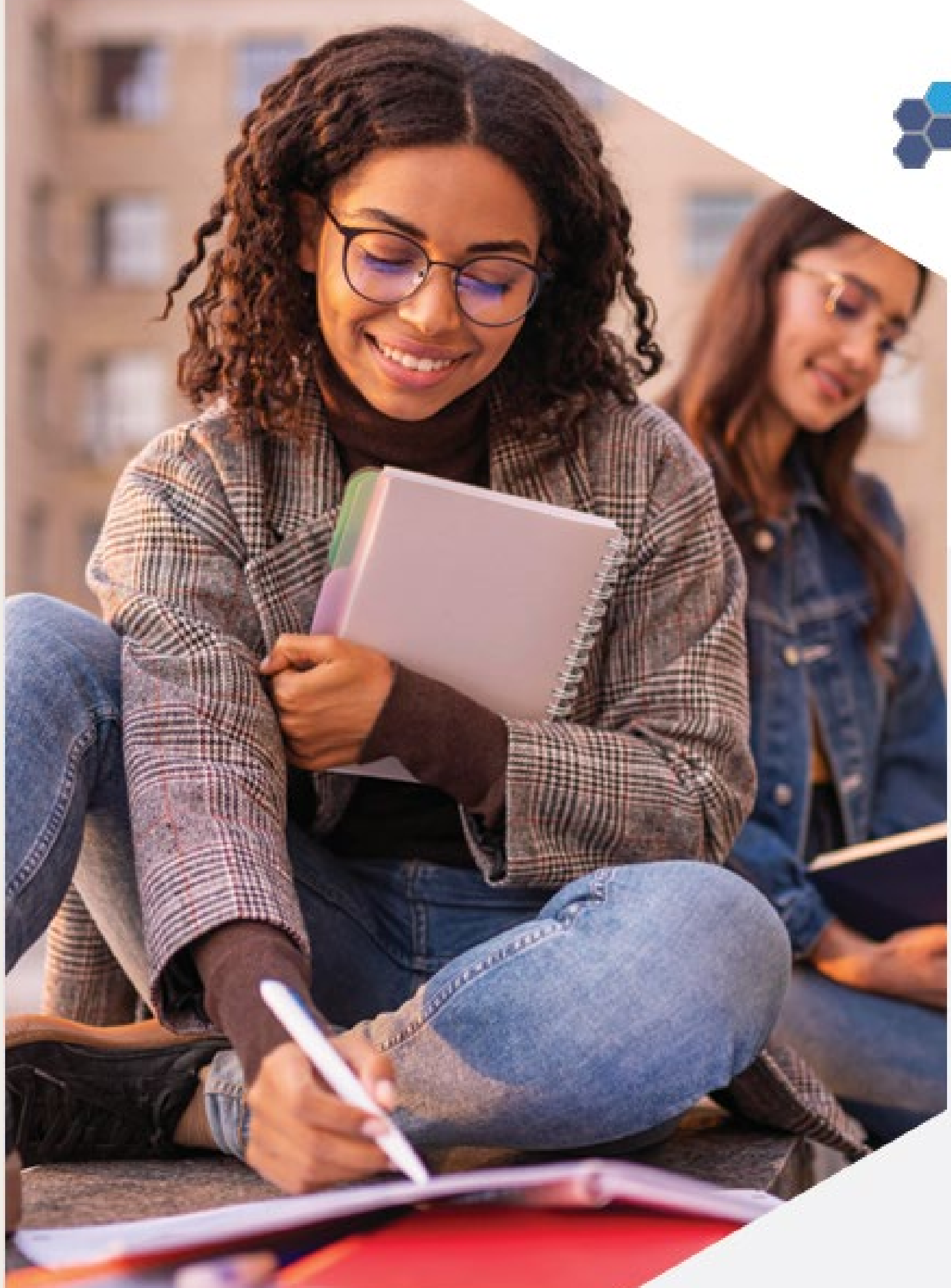
Most universities offer income-based bursaries. These don't require repayment and are automatic with student finance application.

Merit Scholarships

Awarded for academic, sport or music excellence. Application deadlines often fall before UCAS submissions.

Industry Sponsorships

Companies may fund students in relevant fields, sometimes with employment obligations after graduation.

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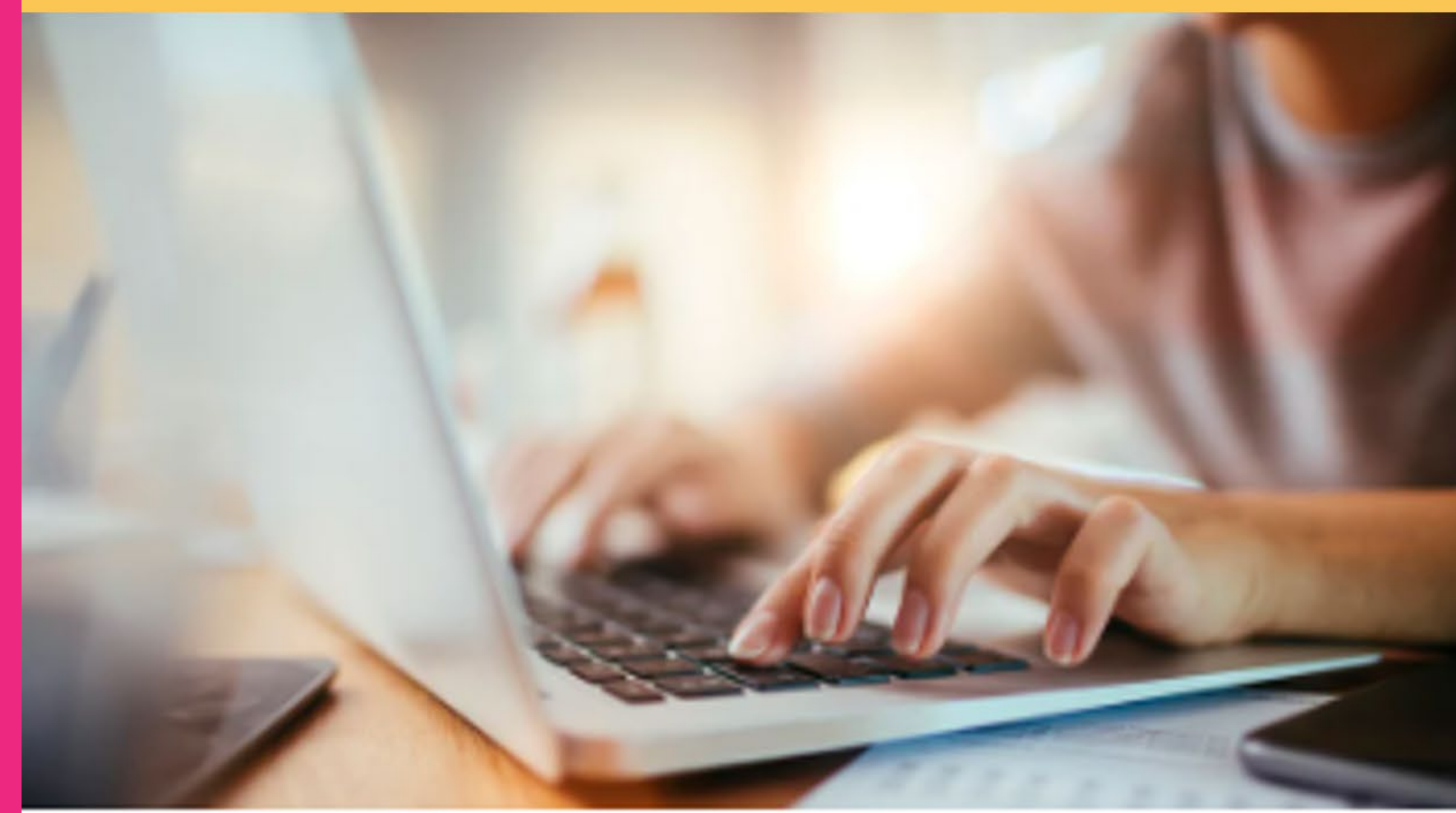
