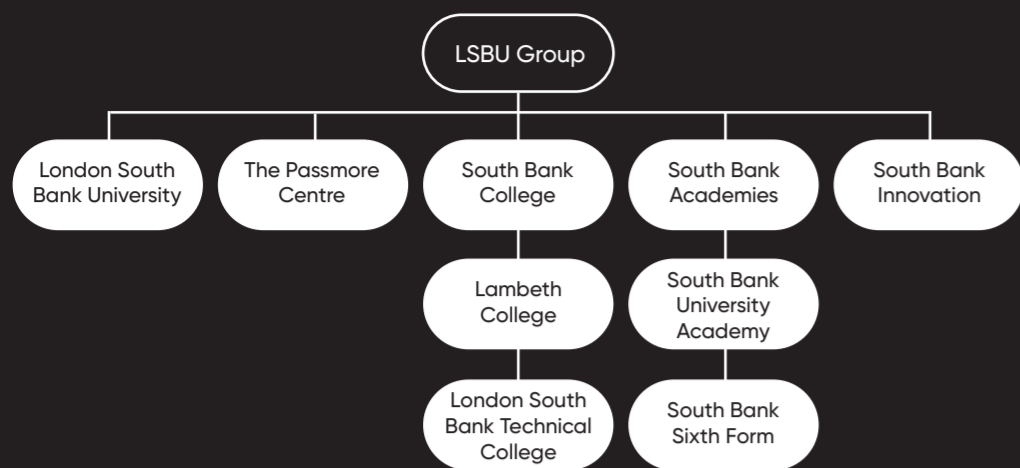

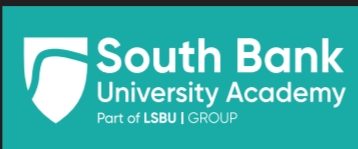

The Need for Beauty Roles

The UK beauty industry employs around 590,000 people, accounting for one in every 50 jobs in the UK.

The number of hair and beauty businesses in the UK increased by 2,215 to 48,425 between March 2021 and March 2022.

Beauty content on YouTube had a mesmerizing 169 billion views. (Yuya is a beauty content creator with over 24.8 million subscribers).

The UK skincare market grew by 9.3% last year, making it the fastest-growing category in the beauty industry. The UK nail care market is also rapidly growing, at a rate of 5.5% (2019-2024)

Add to this the ever-increasing reach of social media influencers, make-up artists and vloggers who are leading the internet beauty charge, and it's clear to see that the latest beauty and wellness trends have never been more accessible or desirable.

You'll need to have excellent customer service skills; great active listening and verbal communication skills; the ability to follow precise instructions; excellent practical and technical skills; in-depth knowledge of cosmetology techniques, skills and care; a thorough approach to your work, attention to detail and the ability to work under pressure; the ability to work well with your hands; the ability to sell products and services; good interpersonal skills and a calm, approachable and friendly manner; sensitivity and understanding; the ability to both work well with others and on your own; a high-level of creativity, flair and artistry; an interest in fashion and style trends; the ability to carry out basic tasks on a computer or hand-held device; and, if you're self-employed, you'll need business acumen and numeracy skills.

Careers in Beauty

According to the British Beauty Council's 'Value of Beauty 2023' report, 25% more small and medium beauty enterprises were registered in 2022 in comparison to 2015. This growth is five times faster than the number of small businesses formed in the manufacturing industry in the same period.

In fact, beauty salons and nail salons ranked in the top 10 fastest-growing retail categories last year, and people in the UK spent £8.6 billion at hairdressers and personal care salons. Even though more than 25% of hair and beauty businesses employ more than five people, and 5% employ more than ten people, a huge 65% of beauty workers have chosen to be self-employed (a 57% growth from 2019).

So, what do these stats mean for your career prospects in the beauty industry? Quite simply, that now is a fantastic time to be embarking on an exciting new pathway, increasing your existing qualifications, or upskilling towards a new beauty direction.

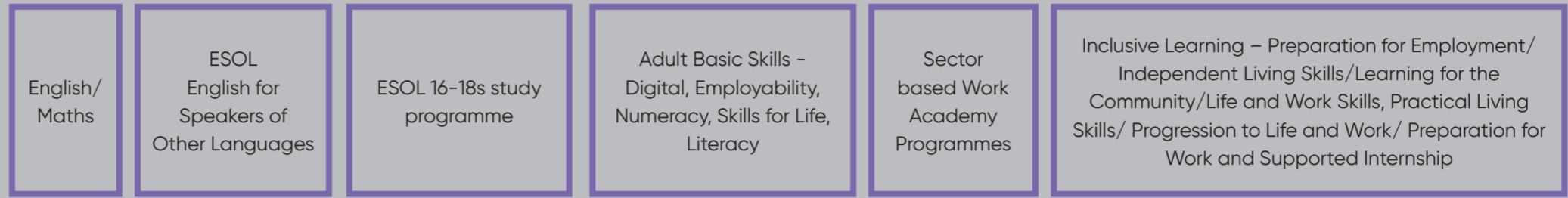
While training, a Beauty Therapist tends to earn around £17k, but once qualified and experienced, salaries range between £21k to £28k (with a national average of £23k p.a.); a qualified Laser Hair Removal Therapist earns between £23k to £30k per year, with a national average of £25,500; Make-up Artist start at around £21k per year while training, but increase to an average of £26k with experience, while the most experienced can earn up to £40k p.a.; a newly-qualified Nail Technician earns around £22k p.a., with a national average of approximately £24k, but once fully-qualified, but with experience can earn up to £38k; and a Salon Manager earns between £24k to £33k, with an average salary of £26k.

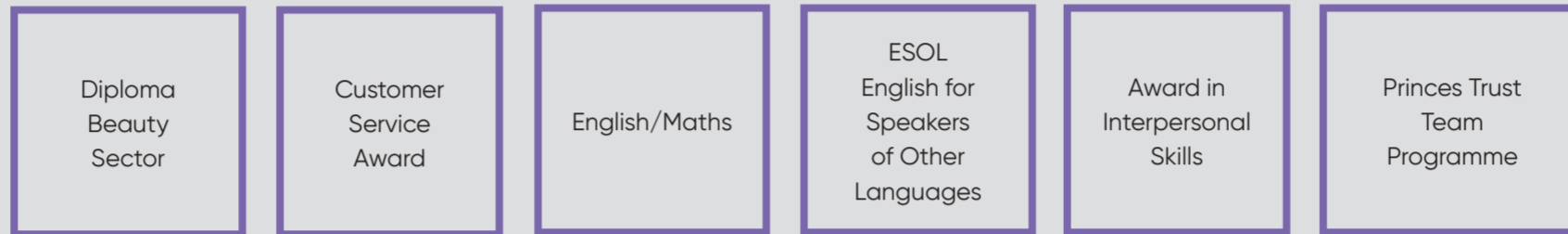
