A Level and AAQ Pathway

SBU Sixth's A Level options focus on Biomedical Science and Engineering. The combinations of subjects offered in each enable progression to degree places at leading universities or higher apprenticeships. Advanced Academic Qualifications (AAQ) are a new qualification, equivalent to one A-Level and carrying UCAS points. The AAQ curriculum emphasises practical, career-focused skills.

Entry requirements for the A Level pathway are Grade 6 in GCSE English Language and Maths as well as at least three other subjects.

Biomedical Science

Includes Biology, Chemistry and Maths A Levels.

Business

Includes Maths A Level, and Business Studies and Finance Studies AAQs.

Engineering

Includes Maths and Physics A Levels, and Engineering AAQ.

T Level Pathway

T-Levels are exciting qualifications for Sixth Form students, combining a high standard of knowledge with career-focused skills and a long industrial placement.

SBU Sixth is now in its third year of providing T-Levels and our students to date have achieved excellent results, including 75% of Finance students receiving a Distinction in 2025.

Students select one specialism to study full time, with 80% of hours over the course in the Sixth Form and 20% on an industrial placement with a relevant employer.

The entry requirements for the T-Level pathway are GCSEs at Grade 5 in English Language and Maths, as well as at least three other subjects.

About T Levels

T Levels are a 2-year qualification that you can do after GCSEs as an alternative to A levels, other post-16 courses or an apprenticeship.

They have been designed with leading businesses and employers to give you the

knowledge and skills you need for a successful, sustainable career.

Technical Pathway

Our BTEC and other Level 3 vocational qualifications provide a progression route into careers and degree courses. They focus on practical skills with a strong emphasis on relating study to the workplace.







The campus, built as a specialist educational facility in 2017, has a large cafe and social area, courtyard, well-equipped gym, library, two areas for private study, and simulator room.



At the interview evening, you will offered a place at SBUSixth. Your offer will confirm what grades you will need to take up a place on your first choice of course.
